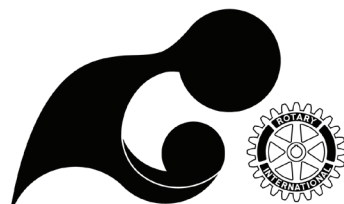

Feb. 23 Mark Kinsler, Lancaster Eagle-Gazette columnist

Born in 1947 in Cleveland, Ohio, which he still likes and considers home, Mark Kinsler has had the privilege of living in fine and fascinating places as he figured out what he was going to do with his life. After a spell at Ohio State University, he figured he'd better learn a trade, and so he learned enough electronics to work in both broadcast engineering and the audio-repair trade. When that got tedious, he went back to school, continuing his repair work and teaching electronics to support the effort, until

he found that if you go to school long enough they'll finally hand you a doctorate (electrical engineering, 1995, Mississippi State University) and tell you to go away. In the process of getting all that schooling, he learned about the production of artificial lightning in the laboratory and about protecting buildings and utilities against lightning damage. Kinsler started writing for the Eagle-Gazette in November, 2005 after he dropped off a bundle of articles he'd written on various topics to the editor, who liked them. He mostly writes about domestic issues like filling salt shakers, laying basement floors and the hazards of cooking unauthorized chicken parts in the sacred microwave oven. Besides writing and learning about very old houses, Kinsler teaches science and engineering wherever he can—in articles, via the Internet, and at school and museum demonstrations—and looks after the family cats and motor vehicles.
