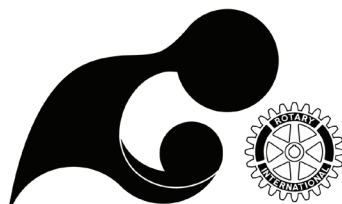

Mar. 9. **Mary Taylor**, Ohio's Auditor of State
Mary Taylor is the first certified public accountant to serve as Ohio's Auditor of State. She previously served two terms in the Ohio House of Representatives where she served on the House Finance, Ways and Means, and Education committees. Taylor began her career in public service as a city councilwoman in Green, Ohio.

Auditor Taylor obtained a bachelor's degree in accounting and a master's degree in taxation from the University of Akron. Taylor began her career in 1990 with Deloitte and Touche. She joined the regional firm of Bober Markey Fedorovich & Company in 1994, where she was director of the firm's tax department and senior manager of the employee benefits practice.

Taylor was recently honored as a 2008 recipient of the University of Akron's Dr. Frank L. Simonetti Distinguished Business Award. She has also been honored by the National White Collar Crime Center, as recipient of its 2008 Member Agency Award for Excellence. Taylor is one of three women appointed to represent the United States as a delegate to the 52nd session of the United Nations Commission on the Status of Women. The commission is a functional commission of the United Nations Economic and Social Council, dedicated exclusively to gender equality and the advancement of women.
