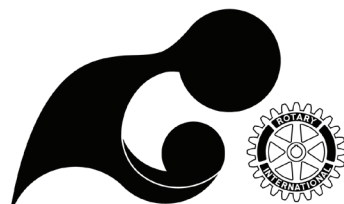

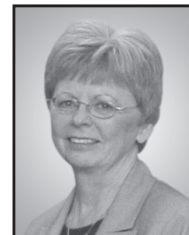
Joanie Reeder
