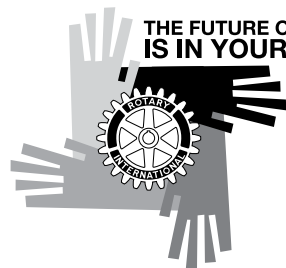

Dave Phalen has 39 years of law enforcement experience and is currently serving his third term as sheriff. In 1970 he started with the Washington D.C. Police Department as a police officer and detective and then spent 27 years with the Columbus, Ohio Police Department, retiring at the rank of lieutenant, after working in the narcotics bureau, vice bureau and patrol division.



He has received numerous commendations and awards, but the one he is most proud is the "Ohio Distinguished Law Enforcement Award" presented to him in 2004 by the Ohio Attorney General for 35 years of law enforcement service. He hosts a weekly radio program on WFCO 90.9 FM, as well as a monthly television program "SAFETY FIRST", shown locally on Time Warner Cable. He has also been featured in USA Today newspaper, and on Fox News and CNN television programs.
